<u>WHEREAS</u>, The New Jersey Annual School Planning Process consolidates multiple needs-assessment processes into one coherent system; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>. The New Jersey Annual School Planning Process serves as a framework for long-term, sustained improvement that is considered best practice, and, therefore, is available for all New Jersey schools; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, a schoolwide program is a comprehensive reform strategy designed to upgrade the entire educational program in a Title I school with a poverty percentage at or above 40 percent or in a Title I school with a poverty percentage below 40 percent that was granted an eligibility waiver exception by the state educational agency; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, operating a schoolwide program should result in an ongoing effort to bolster the academic achievement of the entire school community while tailoring reform strategies and interventions to meet the unique needs of all students, staff, and families; and

<u>WHEREAS</u>, all eleven elementary schools completed their Annual School plans with stakeholder input by the June 30, 2022 deadlines for Title I schoolwide status; and

WHEREAS, the Annual School Plans will be available on each school's website; and

BE IT RESOLVED, The following eleven Annual School Plans be accepted for the 2022-2023 school year.
