Please note: While it is not the Board's intention to stifle comment on matters of legitimate concern to the school community, the public should be aware that if their statements violate the rights of others under the law governing defamation or invasion of privacy, they may face personal liability to the injured party.

If speakers are uncertain of the legal ramifications of their comments, the Board urges them to seek guidance beforehand from their own legal advisor

WHEREAS, this Board of Education of the City of Bayonne, Hudson County, New Jersey deems it necessary to have professional learning sessions from November 2024 through June 2025, with consultants from National Employment 360 for the following; and

WHEREAS, this Bayonne Board of Education agrees with National Employment 360 to provide an exciting new opportunity for students ages 14 to 21 years. Wellness2Work is a unique pre-employment training program designed to help students with vocational skills, job placement, self-advocacy, social skills, and other qualities necessary for facilitating and supporting independence; and

WHEREAS, this Bayonne Board of Education has determined that the professional learning sessions for Bayonne Alternative High School students with varying disabilities, mental health diagnoses, and medical conditions can receive direct instruction and ongoing support in five skill areas (5 Pillars):

1. Job Exploration Counseling.
2. Work-Based Learning Experiences (WBLE), which may include in-school, after-school, or community-based opportunities.
3. Counseling on opportunities for enrollment in Comprehensive Transition or Postsecondary Education programs at Institutions of Higher Education (IHE).
4. Workplace Readiness Training to develop social skills and independent living skills.
5. Instruction in self-advocacy, including peer mentoring.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that this Board of Education hereby approves such professional development at no cost.

Whereas, Riverside Insights Cognitive Ability Assessments (CogAT) offer valuable insights into students' cognitive abilities and learning styles;

Whereas, CogAT scores serve three primary purposes:

1. To guide instructional strategies to meet the diverse needs and abilities of all students,
2. To provide a reliable measure of cognitive development,
3. To identify students whose expected achievement levels differ significantly from their actual performance;

Whereas, the assessment provides individual domain scores, partial composites, and complete test composites for each student who completes the test, offering a comprehensive profile of student ability;

Whereas, the CogAT utilizes age-specific (in years and months) national and local norms that meet rigorous standards for accuracy and relevance;

Therefore, it resolved that the Board of Education will implement the CogAT for Kindergarten, Grade 2, Grade 4 and Grade 7 students as a standardized assessment to inform instructional planning, address individual learning needs, and identify discrepancies between cognitive potential and achievement.

Be it further resolved that the cost to facilitate the CogAT assessment is \$58,103.24, covering student licenses, scoring services, and database platform access for three years.

 - Annual informational session for Board employees.

Marketing and Recognition

Kean may include the Board's name and logo on marketing materials with prior consent and may highlight the Board in promotional campaigns or events.

District Responsibilities

- Make reasonable efforts to meet a 15-employee enrollment minimum.
- Actively promote the partnership benefits and provide informational materials.
- Designate a liaison to coordinate with Kean University and confirm employee eligibility.



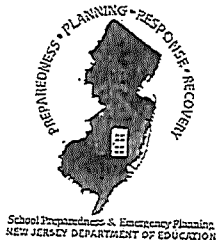


