All speakers are requested to express themselves in a civil manner, with due respect for the dignity and privacy rights of others whose legal rights may be affected.
Please note: While it is not the Board's intention to stifle comment on matters of legitimate concern to the rights of others under the low coverning defamation or invasion of privacy. When you for expand I liability to the injured party.
