Please note: While it is not the Board's intention to stifle comment on matters of legitimate concern to the school community, the public should be aware that if their statements violate the rights of others under the law governing defamation or invasion of privacy, they may face personal liability to the injured party.

If speakers are uncertain of the legal ramifications of their comments, the Board urges them to seek guidance beforehand from their own legal advisor

<u>WHEREAS</u>, this Board of Education of the City of Bayonne, Hudson County, New Jersey deems it desirous and necessary to enter into the following agreement with Kean University to:

- develop a collaborative relationship with Kean University that will enrich high school students knowledge of and sensitivity to Holocaust and genocide studies through a 3-credit undergraduate course, *ID 1800: Holocaust, Genocide, and Modern Humanity* (aka: Facing History and Ourselves) offered on-site at Bayonne High School; School students will be charged a reduced rate of \$100 per credit for the 3-credit ID 1800 course for a total cost of \$300. Students shall submit payment for the course to Kean University at the time of registration.

<u>WHEREAS</u>, this Board of Education enters into an agreement with Kean University to provide these services starting September 2024 for a period of two (2) years and will expire on June 30, 2026. This Agreement may be renewed for one (1) additional year, upon the mutual written consent of the Parties, and therefore

<u>Whereas</u>, the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) requires states to use a set of indicators to measure the performance of all schools. The indicators for academic progress and student success are required for accountability and also include, Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM Proficiency), New Jersey Student Learning Assessment (NJSLA) and New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment (NJPA); and

<u>Whereas</u>, all accountability measures must be supported by research showing that performance and /or progress are likely to increase, allow for meaningful differentiation of schools, be disaggregated by subgroup, and be valid and reliable across all schools in a particular grade span; and

<u>Whereas</u>, to ensure school districts are transparent and held accountable to the district board of education regarding the proficiency and growth of students on statewide assessments by presenting analysis that includes subgroups, comparison data, and intervention strategies that correspond to the data; and

<u>Therefore be it resolved</u>, that Dr. Wachera Ragland-Brown, Chief Academic Officer, presented proficiency and growth of students via analysis and deliverance of the New Jersey Student Learning Assessment (NJSLA), New Jersey Graduation Proficiency Assessment (NJGPA), and Dynamic Learning Maps (DLM) state assessment data on October 15, 2024.


